Year 4 Term Three 2022

TERM OUTLINE

English

Students will undertake a book study of Rowan of Rin. They will discuss characters and events in the book to deepen their understanding of the underlying messages. Students will use this knowledge to write a book review on Rowan of Rin.



Maths

This term students will examine the area of common 2D shapes and the volume of 3D prisms. This includes hands on experiences like building prisms with cubes.

They will begin exploring decimals by extending their place value knowledge to the tenths and hundredths. They will solve problems that include decimals.

Students will also use scaled instruments to measure and compare lengths, masses, capacities and temperatures:

Temperature – thermometer Length - ruler Capacity – jugs Mass - scales

HANDS ON LEARNING

Science

We will be testing the properties of materials, such as cardboard, paper, fabric, aluminum foil and plastic. This will lead us to design appropriate packaging that protects a fragile object. Students will make predictions, conduct experiments and analyse results throughout the unit.



Students will learn about health and safety. They will explore safe choices in relation to sun, road, beach,

They will study significant dates and events in the voyages of James Cook and the First Fleet to Australia. They will investigate life in 18th century Britain and the conditions aboard the ships of the First Fleet and convict life in the new colony.
