TERM 3 OUTLINE

English

Students will be exploring a range of different procedures. They will learn about the structure and features of the text. Students will have fun making and creating, while learning to write and follow procedures.

Students will work on improving their reading decoding, fluency and comprehension skills. Students can practise these skills at home by reading both familiar and new books each night.

Sight Words are a **very important** part of the reading process in Year 1. Please ensure that students are practising their sight words **every** night.

Maths

SUBTRACTION

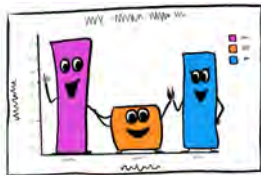
This term, students will be learning about subtraction. They will use strategies such as counting back, tens frames, pictures and number lines. Students will also utilise the See, Plan, Do, Check model to solve word problems.

DATA

Students will learn about how to collect data, represent it using simple displays and answer questions relating to the data.

MONEY

Students will explore Australian coins and the ways and reasons we use money in every day life. They will identify coins by their features and order them in terms of their value.



Science

Students will focus on making, recording and communicating observations of the environment and events within. Students will observe landscapes such as farm, beach, school and natural as well as changes within events such as growing gardens. Students will explore the observable changes between day and night.



HASS

This term in HASS we are studying our natural and built environment. Students will be classifying different environments as natural, managed or constructed. Students will be out and about in the school grounds creating labelled drawings of the managed and constructed features of our school.

Homework

Homework is the same for all classes. It should be returned each week to your class teacher.

Please check in with your child's teacher if you are unsure of any part of the homework.

As a part of homework, students should be reading a variety of books each week. Readers are supplied by the school and are sent home weekly. You can also access the school library and the local Council library.

Please take care with home readers to make sure they are kept safe and returned to school in good condition.
